It is not too early to make your arrangements to attend our next Group reunion at San Antonio, Oct 8-12, 1986. The Texas reunion team headed up by MAX AXELSEN, 403rd, and LLOYD BOREN, 65th, have great plans for you which are detailed later in this letter.

HAROLD & LOUISE BARRETT, 403rd, O'Donnell, TX visited Clark Field on a Valour tour last October. The tour group had an audience with President Marcos, led the parade at Tacloban in the ebration of the 41st anniversary of the landing at Leyte Gulf. They spent a day at Clark Field and a day at Corregidor. At Hong Kong a member of the RAF Association, Roger Draper, persuaded HAROLD to go on Radio Hong Kong to relate how the 43rd Bomb Group bombed Victoria Harbor with 55 gallon drums of napalm in May of 1945. Harold joined the 43rd at Clark Field in il 1945. He was a B-24 pilot and was flying missions against Japan from Ie Shima when the war ended. The BARRETT'S plan to be with us at San Antonio.

JOE GREEN, 403rd, Valdosta, Georgia, wrote to give us the sad news that one of our real old timers, ALFRED L. CURRY, 403rd, Columbus, Georgia died last March at the age of 78. AL was in the 49th Sqdn of the 2nd Bomb Group at Langley Field and in the 13th Reconn at Bangor, and went over on the Argentina. The real sad message in JOE'S words was, "I had been meaning to drive up to Columbus and see him but just kept putting it off and off until now its' too late." JOE will be at San Antonio. I think that it will be his first 43rd reunion.

VERNA & JOHN MC CRUM, 403rd, Mt Vernon, Ohio regret that ill health will prevent their attendance at the reunion. Their new address is on the new roster, and I am sure they would appreciate a card or note from those of you who know them.

HORACE "ACE" CAREY, 403rd, Mt Laurel, New Jersey, tells us he retired from the ministry and now serves a 1300 member Methodist Church as Visiting Pastor. He joined the 403rd at Townsville in Oct 42, and left from Ie Shima in Aug 45.

of our most generous supporters, BILL SPENCE, Hdqrs, Virginia Beach, Virginia, remembers HarRY ELLIS, 65th, Fairless Hills, Penn. as one of the men he helped train in the 43rd using the facilities of a WRAN'S radio school in Sydney and offers the following answer to one of HARRY'S in the last newsletter. "Maybe HARRY was best man for AL DOXEY, MAYNARD BRANDT or BILLY GRISSOM at a Sydney wedding. I attended Al'S and MAYNARD'S (double wedding), but not BILLY'S. BILLY later died of typhus in New Guinea at Seven Mile."

Several people have responded to HARRY'S other question concerning the tail gunner that bailed out over Rabaul Harbor. He was PFC ARTHUR "ROCKY" MIRARCHI. He landed in the water and was taken on board the Japanese destroyer MAKINAMI on Feb 23rd 1943. His ultimate fate is unknown but his name is inscribed on the memorial at the American Cemetary in Manila. He was a close buddy to ED TROCCIA, 65th, Poughkeepsie, New York.

JOHN CROCKETT, 64th, Riverside, Calif., pilot of another plane on that Feb 23rd mission saw MIRACHI going down in the lights over Rabaul. JOHN is a dentist and was in the 19th BG on the way to the Philippines but got caught at Hickam Field on December 7th. Stayed with the 19th through Australia, Horn Island, then into Moresby. He was transferred to the 43rd when the 19th went home. He calls himself DAVY, so I expect we will see him at the Alamo in October.

ED TROCCIA also straightened us out on the correct names of the artists who created the cartoons in Life and Down Under. They were PAT BURKE & JIM CONGLETON. PAT was Bombardier and JIM was pilot on BRUCE GIBSON'S crew in the 403rd.

The 380th association has established a still relationship with the current 380th Bomb Wing which is stationed at Plattsburgh AFB, New YOLK. They have a museum at Plattsburgh and are holding a reunion there this Sept.
